

Old Cemetery Will Be Sold at Auction

An unneeded five acres of land in the county cemetery, 3301 E. 1st St., will be auctioned in the Board of Supervisors hearing room Dec. 3 at 9:30 a.m., with a minimum bid of \$126,000 required.

Robert B. Heuer, county real estate director, said burials in the potter's field

stopped when cremation began in 1922.

Any cemetery purchasing the acreage presumably would put in a fill of 4 to 14 feet over existing gravesites. No law forbids placing of new graves over old if proper records and markers are maintained.
