Burial Sought for Unclaimed

Ashes of 6200 bodies of persons who have died in county institutions and who were cremated at the County Cemetery held the attention of the Board of Supervisors for several minutes yesterday when a request was presented by William R. Harriman, County Superintendent of Charities, to bury them. The matter was referred to the County Counsel. According to Harriman the ashes, some of them held from two to nine years, are overcrowding space in the storage building at the cemetery.
